

Multiplication Tic-Tac-Toe

Players use cubes in two different colors. The first player chooses two factors (from 1-9, underneath the game board); places a paper clip on each, and marks the product on the game board with a cube. The second player moves **one** of the paper clips to a new factor, finds the product and marks the product with a different color cube. Play continues until one player has marked four products in a row, column, or diagonal.

Note: If moving a paperclip, it's legal to move it to the same factor as the other paper clip to allow for plays such as 5×5 .
