Teams will review assessment from other schools and provide feedback. Teams will collect district/school data. Teams will field test assessments. LCI and CA BOCES staff will teach participants content specific assessment development. Participants will review student work to examine how it aligns with assessment results. Evaluation of assessments by the review panel. Participate in the secure network provided by NYSED.
